BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Peter H. Myers was born February 1840 in Rockingham County, died April 18 1913 in Greenmount, VA. Mr. Myers is buried in Greenmount Brethren Church cemetery. He was married in Rockingham County on December 21, 1865 to Elizabeth Burkeholder (born 1841, died October 4, 1887, daughter of Abram Burkeholder). Mr. Myers enlisted in 1861 at Harrisonburg as 1st Corporal in Company F, 146th Virginia Militia. (From Rockingham County Men in Grey, p. 286).
