**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:**

Samuel Angus Firebaugh of Mt. Clinton enlisted in the Confederate Army, Company H, 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Infantry on June 14, 1861. He kept a diary from September 1862 to March of 1864. The diary begins a week after the Battle of Antietam and ends shortly before the opening of the Wilderness Campaign in northern Virginia.
